

Software Center

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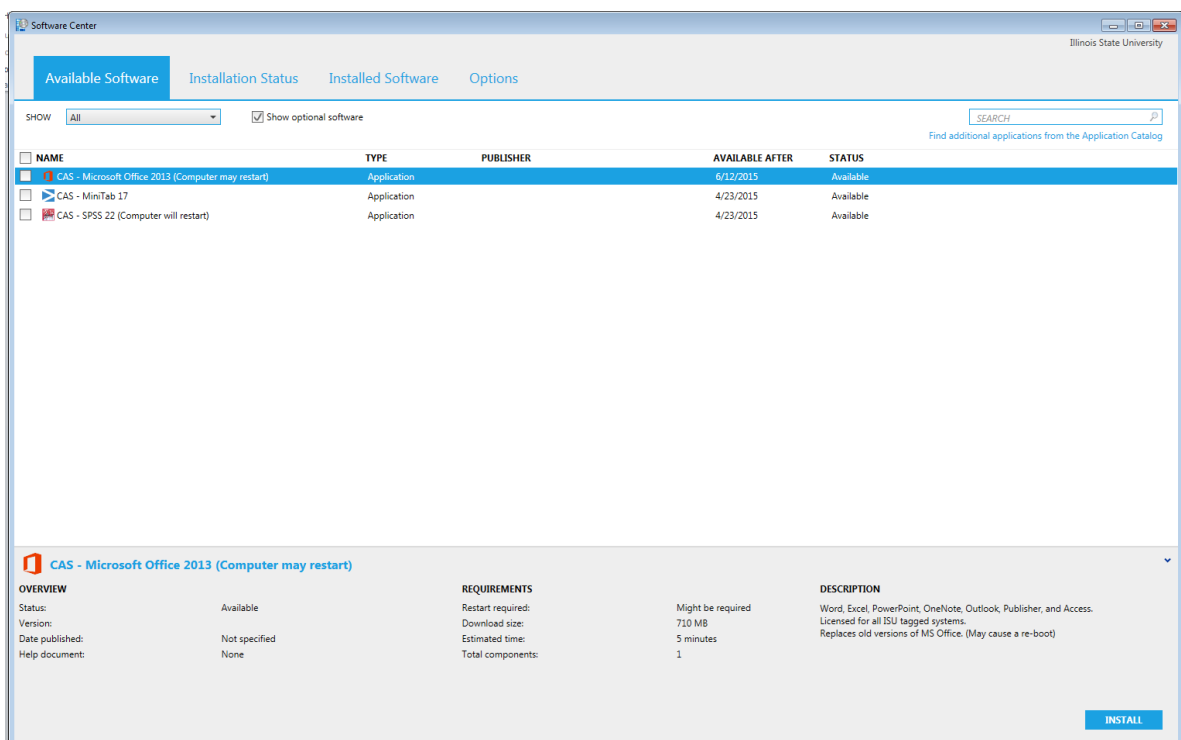
Software Center is an application that is installed on all computers with the Microsoft Windows operating system where you log in using your ULID and password. Software available on each computer may vary. Contact CAS-IT if you have any questions on the software available to you. Software Center lets users do the following:

- Browse for and install software for free.
- View their software request history.
- Configure when Configuration Manager can install software on their devices.

Getting to Software Center

1. Click *Start Menu>Programs>Microsoft System Center>Configuration Manager>Software Center*

Downloading Software

1. Click on the **Available Software** tab to see the list of free software that can be downloaded.
2. Select the software you wish to download and click **Install** located at the bottom right of the window. If you wish to download more than one program, select the boxes on the left of each software program and then click **Install Selected** at the bottom right corner.

My Software Did Not Download

The **Installation Status** tab allows you to see the progress of your downloads. If the application does not install correctly, you will have to option to download again.

1. Click on the **Installation Status** tab.
2. Select the software you wish to download.
3. Click **Reinstall** at the bottom right corner of the window.

Uninstalling Software

1. Click the **Installed Software** tab.
2. Select the software that you would like to uninstall. You may only select one at one time.
3. Click **Uninstall** at the bottom right corner of the window.
