He further expressed concerns about the software, noting, "Let's say we have a major and we want to add a sequence; we get a software error." **Lisa Tranel** mentioned that the geology department has already fixed this issue within their department.

Rocio Rivadeneyra brought up the issue of proposals getting approved but becoming stuck in the registrar's office and not being added to the catalog. She added that she will ensure this does not happen in the future.

It was discussed that when a sequence is proposed, there should be a sequence application form included.

Fusun Akman found the syllabus lacking clarity, particularly concerning evaluations, which were not stated clearly. The syllabus contained a 10% participation grade that was not mentioned, contact hours were 2.5 when they should be 3, and attendance accounted for 50%, which committee members found excessive.

John Hooker suggested deleting the last statement in the accommodation statement, as it was not intended for students. **Todd Stewart** raised a motion to reject, but **Fusun Akman** requested resubmission. **John Hooker** seconded.

Decision: Resubmit.

All present members voted to resubmit; Alan Lessoff abstained.

25-006 MAT: Data Science and Computational Mathematics Sequence

Todd Stewart mentioned that the proposal makes sense but noted a tactical issue: MAT 252 was replaced by MAT 205, but no strikeout was indicated. He suggested sending it back.

Rocio Rivadeneyra suggested tabling the request until more information is available.

Todd Stewart raised the question of whether a letter of concurrence from IT is needed to replace IT 244 with IT 215. He also asked if a letter of non-objection from IT is required.

Todd Stewart moved to table.

Decision: Table.

25-007 PSY: Specialist in School Psychology

John Hooker asked to reject the first proposal and requested more time to review a new submission. **John Hooker** raised a motion to reject, **Fusun Akman** seconded, and everyone voted to reject; no one abstained.

Dr. Alan Lessoff noted that the English department intends to require courses in science writing and legal writing. He identified a typo in the degree plan and pointed out the absence of strikeouts. Dr. Fusun Akman mentioned that the required literature hours were changed from 6 to 3.

Dr. Alan Lessoff checked the course catalog and found that the relevant courses (ENG 249 and ENG 280) are intended for fall offerings but are not currently available. Dr. Fusun Akman clarified that classes are sometimes not offered if student registration is low. Todd Stewart mentioned that the courses might be offered biennially. Dr. Sarah O'Dowd confirmed a spring offering, and Rocio Rivadeneyra mentioned a fall 2023 offering.

Todd Stewart requested strikeouts and typo corrections in the proposal. Dr. Fusun Akman also identified a discrepancy in the total minimum credits, suggesting it be adjusted to 119 or 120 by increasing ENG 398 credits.

Decision: Dr. Alan Lessoff moved for approval pending corrections, and Dr. Fusun Akman seconded. All were in favor, with Robbie Graham abstaining.

25-013 ANT 478 & 25-014 ANT 378: Evolution and Human Biological Diversity
